Maths

This week we have been finding halves and quarters of shapes. Can you draw shapes and cut them into these fractions? Maybe you can cut your toast into halves or a banana into quarters! We have also been finding fractions of numbers: Kittens - halves of numbers to 20, Cats – halves of numbers to 50 and Tigers - halves and quarters of numbers to 50. If you practise this at home and bring it in to school you know that you will get Team Points!

English

In English this week we have been telling the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears but from Goldilocks' point of view. When you are reading, think about how other characters in the book might be feeling. How would they tell the story? We have also written a recount of our trip to the Gudwara, using different sentence openers. We have used time words like First, Next, Then, After that, Later, Finally. But we also used adverbs and phrases: Carefully, Respectfully, A little while later, My favourite part of the day was. Can you write a recount of something that you do during the week using those openers?
