Document your findings and bring them in to share with the class for team points.

At the end of last term in our English lessons we were looking at features of non-fiction books. For homework we would like you to find your favourite information book. Look through the book at the headings and photographs. Use your book to make a fact sheet about your favourite section. Remember to include a title, sub-heading, a hand-drawn picture, capital letters and full stops. Can you include some questions too?
